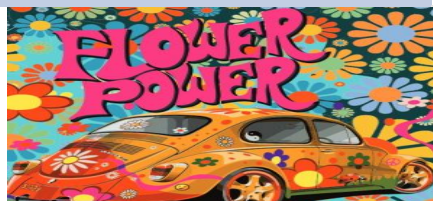
**July 8-12**
